i Packed Lunch Boxes

Packed Lunch Advice - fewer than 1% of packed lunches in schools meet the School Food Standards. We would love Sandbrook packed lunches to be as healthy as our school dinners so as from next week we will be providing advice on the contents of packed lunches. The School Foods Standards state that schools can serve no more than two portions a week of food that has been deep-fried, batter-coated or breadcrumb-coated, no more than two portions of food which include pastry each week (applies across the whole school day), no snacks, except nuts, seeds, vegetables and fruit with no added salt, sugar or fat (applies across the whole school day). Savoury crackers or breadsticks can be served at lunch with fruit or vegetables or dairy food. Schools can serve no confectionery, chocolate and chocolate-coated products, (applies across the whole school day). Desserts, cakes and biscuits are allowed at lunchtime. They must not contain any confectionery. In the first instance we will be reviewing packed lunches and providing information to parents before we develop a packed lunch policy that is fair for all pupils in school.
