- Improve progress in reading and mathematics in KS2.
- > Improve attendance of pupils and reduce the number who are regularly absent.
- Build capacity in leadership by developing the middle leaders.

We are committed to addressing these issues as speedily as possible. Please be assured of our continued drive and commitment to securing consistently good teaching for all children in KS2 so that outcomes by Y6 are as strong as the outcomes in EYFS and KS1.
