Nature of support 2011/12

A full complement of teachers was employed to maintain small-sized single year-group classes.

Additional support from teaching assistants in the classroom was funded to facilitate small group teaching, intervention programmes and to focus on identified children in various year groups for 1 to 1 work.

Pressure Point service was bought in to support the social emotional needs of some children.

Monies were allocated to subsidise residential visits, school trips and enhancement activities.

The LA curriculum support package for staff development activities was bought into to continually improve the quality of teaching that children receive.

Subscription to a Pupil Progress Tracker was funded to ensure that the right support can be targeted at the right children as soon as possible.

SEN support was bought in to help early identification of pupils with additional needs.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

Sandbrook Primary School will evaluate the impact on each pupil during this term (Autumn 2012).

Evaluation will focus on academic gains and how pupils' self-confidence has developed as a consequence of the intervention.
