The following information was brought to my attention by another headteacher. One of their Y6 pupils had received inappropriate and unwanted messages and requests for video and face to face meet-ups via the App musical.ly. This was reported to the police.

Musical.ly is a popular App that is described:

'Musical.ly makes it easy and fun to create amazing videos and impress your friends. Simply select a sound and start lip synching. Anyone can be an awesome singer with musical.ly'

As you can see from this, it sounds innocent. However, the app allows messaging and the sending of video and this is how it came to cause problem.

Please take care of your child's online safety by checking out what apps they use, which site they visit and setting your parental controls.
