### Geography in School

“ Geography education should inspire in pupils a curiosity and fascination about the world and its people that will remain with them for the rest of their lives.”

This term we have raised the profile of the teaching of geography, investing time and resources to give greater access to ‘hands-on’ experiences to stimulate curiosity, enthusiasm and develop systematic, analytical thinking. We have taken this still further by having a whole school geography day on Friday 8th June. Pictures to follow next week! Please help us to continue to develop the children’s natural curiosity by helping them to explore an Atlas, maps and newspaper articles. Encourage your child to find Britain, Europe and Africa on a map. Allow questions to flow naturally – what is the capital city? Did you know Scotland and Wales have their own capital cities? Let’s find them. Discuss oceans, mountain ranges etc. Google Maps is a great free resource that allows your child to find the answers to such questions. Let’s foster an interest in the world around them!

## Minecraft Club


