Year 4/5 trip to the Wirral Deen Centre

Last week, Year 4/5 took a trip to the Wirral Deen Centre as part of their religious education. The Wirral Deen Centre is an Islamic Organisation open to all people. The organisation has returned to the authentic concept of what a Mosque should provide: a place of worship but most importantly a centre for the whole community to use for communal activities.



Muslims believe that we have an obligation to benefit and serve those around us, irrespective of faith or background. Wirral Deen Centre's vision is to create a local community in Wirral where all people come together as one, living in peace, love and harmony. Islam literally means peace.

Firstly, we were welcomed with a question and answer session followed by a short demonstration of the washing ceremony that takes place before prayer. The children were asked to take off their shoes and enter the Mosque (Masjid). We look forward to continuing to study the religion of Islam over the coming weeks. It was wonderful to see Sandbrook children demonstrating their respect and interest.



"I really enjoyed the trip because when the Quran (the holy book) was read out, it sounded like a song and was really special" – Boran (Year 5)



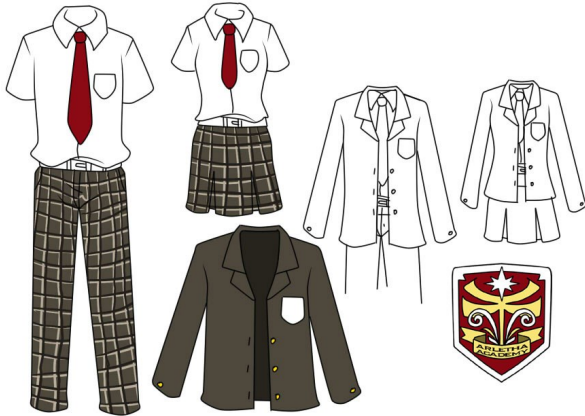
