In PE, the children in year 2/3 have been developing the skills involved with sending and receiving a variety of objects. They have already found out how difficult it is to use their non-dominant hand to throw and catch. Over the next few weeks, they will be working hard to devel-

op the skills needed to play a game of short tennis.

All children need to wear black trousers/shorts/leggings and a red or white school PE top. Football tops are not school uniform.

Multiplication

Over the next few weeks, all children in years 2 and 3 will be developing their understanding of multiplication and division. They will be working hard to use this knowledge when solving word problems and will need to develop their rapid recall ability with these facts. Children in year 2 will be expected to know by heart the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and the children in year 3 will be expected to know the 2, 5, 10 and 3, 4 and 8 times tables.
