Dinner Payments & Free School Meals

Universal free dinners only apply to children in FS2, Y1 and Y2. If your child has just gone into Year 3 and they are having a hot school dinner, there will be a cost of £2.30 per day. If you wish your child to receive a hot meal the cost per week is £11.50, and payment must be sent into school at the beginning of each week in an envelope marked with your child's name, class and monetary amount. Please send in the correct amount as change cannot be given—your account will be credited.

School is classed as a public building, therefore anyone coming to the reception foyer, unless you have a medical reason for not doing so, **MUST** wear a mask. Keep up the good work with preventing the spread of the virus—Keep Wirral Well and we will all be able to stay in school!



Drop-Off Club

Available every morning from 8.05am, cost is £1 per child per session payable at the beginning of the week. Entrance is via the side of reception into the family room.

Due to Covid restrictions office procedures have changed. If you are paying for school meals / breakfast club etc. the correct money must be sent to school in a sealed envelope. To keep money handling to a minimum, we will also now give credit rather than change. For example, if you send in £2.50 / £5 for a school dinner (£2.30), we will credit the whole amount to your child's account. This would be 20p or £2.70 in credit.
