They will explore the techniques and style of the artists and create their own piece.	<u>Local Buildings</u> The pupils will learn about how architecture can be important and visually appealing. They will explore a range of buildings from different times and faiths. They will draw and sculpt.
Y5/6	<u>Figures</u> The pupils will take inspiration from Giacometti, Moore, Rodin and Gormley. They will explore a range of techniques including modelling and sculpting to create their final piece.	<u>Polar Landscapes</u> The pupils will take inspiration from the work of Stokes and images of polar landscapes. They will learn to create mood and atmosphere with paint.	<u>Volcanic Plants</u> The pupils will take inspiration from plant life on volcanic islands. They will explore mixed media to create their final piece.
