Year 6 curriculum

Year 6 have begun an exciting new topic on plate tectonics and natural disasters. We have spent a week exploring the different layers that make up the earth and the fact that the earth's crust is constructed from a number of different plates—a fact that the children found extremely exciting. We then investigated how the plates move in a variety of different ways. The children then learnt that it is the movement of these plates that causes earthquakes. Over the course of the next few weeks we will be learning about tsunamis and volcanoes. We will also be keeping an eye on the news and including any extreme weather patterns or natural disasters in our topic.

This term Year 6 will also be learning about the artist Klimt and visiting the Lady Lever Art Gallery to further enhance their art curriculum. The children will also be studying 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' by Shakespeare and then enjoying a performance of the play. A trip to the local library is also planned for this half term.
