# BE BRIGHT, BE SEEN

# MESSAGE TO ALL PRIMARY SCHOOL CHILDREN AND THEIR PARENTS/CARERS FOR AUTUMN AND WINTER

Please remember that it gets darker earlier in the Autumn and Winter and we all need to make sure we can be seen by drivers when we are out walking or cycling







#### Walking

- Please remember to always wear something bright when you are out in the dark, such as a bright coat, hat and scarf or a rucksack or bag
- Look for a safe place to cross
- Always stop at the kerb or crossing and make sure it is safe to cross
- Hold your grown-up's hand near traffic
- Avoid crossing between parked cars

#### Cycling

- Remember to always wear bright clothing when out on your bike in poor light or darkness
- Remember to <u>turn on</u> your front <u>and</u> back bike lights when it's dark to make sure you are visible to drivers IT'S THE LAW
- ♣ Wearing a cycle helmet protects your head if you come off your bike
- Cycle sensibly and obey the rules of the road

#### Scooting

- Wear something in a bright colour such as a coat or hat and scarf
- Always wear your safety helmet
- Scoot sensibly

#### Travelling by Car

- Ask your grown-up to park a few minutes away from the school when dropping you off and walk with you the last bit to avoid congestion around your school
- Remember to wear something bright so all drivers can see you when you are walking after getting out of the car
