

We are aiming for all children to have an attendance over 97%. Some children are now in the amber and red zones. If your child is in one of these zones, we will need to work together to improve attendance.

 Don't accept friend requests from strangers.
Never share your personal information with people you don't know.
Don't share embarrassing photos or videos of others on line.
Never send naked pictures of yourself to others.
Create a positive online reputation.
Limit your screen time.
Block online bullies.
Report inappropriate content.
Only use Apps which are age appropriate.
Always secure all your social media profiles with a password.
Ask parents to set -up 'parental controls' for social media.
Always talk to your trusted adult if social media is making you unhappy
