Clubs run 3:30 - 4:30 each day.

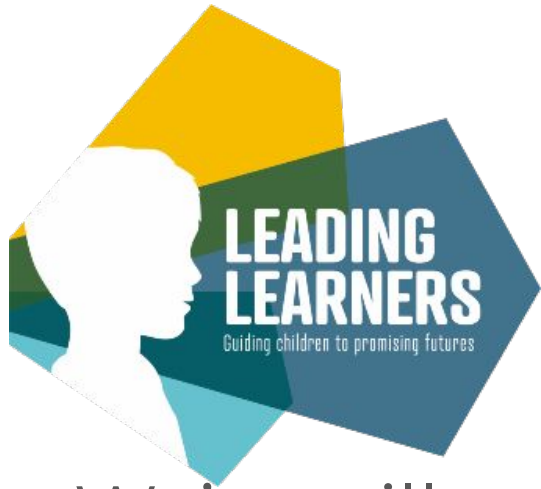
