

- 3. Don't share embarrassing photos or videos of others on line
- 4. Never send naked pictures of yourself to others
- 5. Create a positive online reputation
- 6. Limit your screen time
- 7. Block online bullies
- 8. Report inappropriate content
- 9. Only use Apps which are age appropriate
- 10. Always secure all your social media profiles with a password
- 11. Ask parents to set-up 'parental controls' for social media
- 12. Always talk to your trusted adult if social media is making you unhappy
