Re: Internet Safety

We are all aware of the dangers of children using social media. It has come to our attention that there are a number of tools children are using to communicate with each other outside of school (facebook, whatsapp, oovoo, xbox live and instagram) to name but a few.

We would like to take the opportunity to remind parents that there are age restrictions on some applications (e.g. Facebook has a legal age limit of 13) and children should be encouraged to use all products for positive comments, not as a means to spread rumours or abuse. We would also encourage all parents / carers to closely monitor your child's internet use.

Car Parking
