#### **Dinner Payments & Free School Meals**

The Universal free dinners only apply to children in FS2, Y1 and Y2. If your child has just gone into Year 3 and they are having a hot school dinner, they will be charged at a cost of £2.30 per day. If you wish your child to receive a hot meal the cost per week is £11.50, and payment must be sent into school at the beginning of each week in an envelope marked with your child's name, class and monetary amount.
