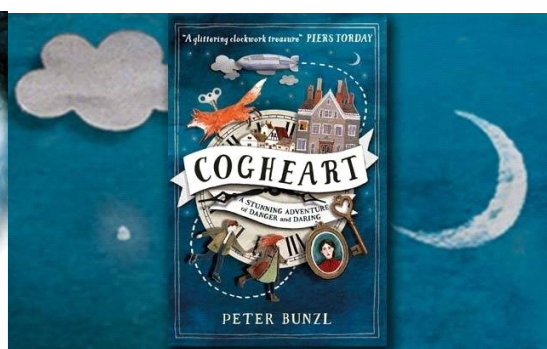
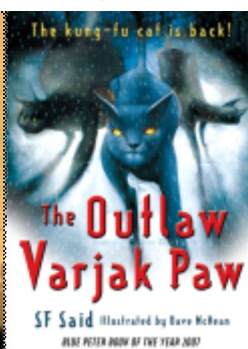
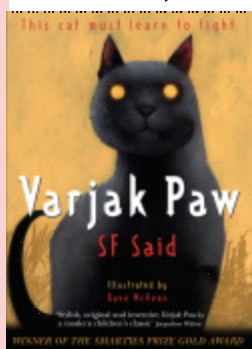

In Year 6 we have also been exploring curiosity and the impact it has on our ability to learn. We have noticed the power of allowing the children to explore questions and the real impact – "stickability" - of the learning that takes place when they discover the answer for themselves.
