Y1/2	<u>Where I Live</u> The pupils will learn about what our immediate area is like. They will learn some key facts about the UK.	<u>Weather</u> The pupils will learn about weather and seasonal weather patterns. They will learn that not all places have the same weather patterns. They will record the weather.	Island Life The pupils will learn about islands. They will learn to describe some coastal features and link these to where we live. They will learn about the British Isles.
Y2/3	<u>Where I live</u> The pupils will learn about Moreton and then compare Moreton with Liverpool. They will learn about transport in each place and how land is used. They will describe each location.	<u>Hot and Cold</u> The pupils will learn about hot and cold zones on the Earth. They will learn about why people might choose to visit or live in certain locations.	<u>The Lake District</u> The pupils will learn about the geography of the Lake District and compare it to Moreton.
Y4/5	<u>Rivers Near Us</u> The pupils will learn about our local rivers. They will learn to describe the physical features of a river as it journeys to the sea. They will learn about the water cycle.	<u>Rivers in Europe</u> Pupils will extend their learning and explore European rivers. They will look at land use and settlement patterns around rivers.	<u>Living in a European Settlement</u> Pupils will stop off in a European settlement. They will learn about its physical and human geography and then compare it to where we live.
Y6	<u>The Americas</u> The pupils will learn about countries in the Americas and key physical features. They will zoom in to study some locations in more detail.	<u>Antarctica</u> The pupils will explore this vast continent and learn about the issues facing its future.	<u>Plate Tectonics</u> Pupils will learn about the Earth's structure and how the tectonic plates create volcanoes and earthquakes.
