Main School Entrance

Please note that unless you have made a prior special arrangement, are late or attending breakfast club, your children should be using the Chapelhill Road entrance to come into school. We cannot let children in through the main entrance prior to the main gates being opened as there is no-one in the classrooms to supervise them. If you would like your child to attend breakfast club, they need to be registered in advance to maintain safe staffing levels. Registration forms are available from the office and the charge is £2 per day, payable in advance.
