Dear parents and carers

It is with a great deal of sadness and some concern that I write to inform you of another spate of negative Facebook-ing. On this occasion the alleged content was of potentially racist nature. We are committed to challenging racism in our school community. A racist incident is anything perceived by the victim or a witness to be motivated by prejudice or hostility against a person because of skin colour, nationality, religion or culture.

If parents or pupils are victims of racial abuse outside school we would encourage the family to report the incident to the police who take every incident very seriously and are very supportive. The number to call to report an incident to the police is 101.

Sandbrook is an inclusive school and all children are taught in school to respect diversity and to welcome opportunities to learn about people who have different ethnicities, faiths and cultural backgrounds.

In school we promote the values of respect and kindness and it saddens me deeply that members of our community have been treated in a way which does not reflect these core values.

If any parent has a concern or issue with what we do in school, then the appropriate course of action is to meet with us to discuss your concerns. We will always listen to your views and take the time to explain our position if it differs from yours.
