Y4/5	<u>Romans</u> The pupils will take inspiration from Roman art and artefacts. They will explore a range of techniques including paint, mosaic, pottery and sculpting to create their final piece.	<u>Old and young masters</u> The pupils will learn about an important art figure. They will explore the techniques and style of the artist of their choice. The pupils will learn art has changed through time.	<u>Religion in art</u> The pupils will learn about how religion uses art. They will explore a range of pieces by different artists from different times and faiths. They will learn how symbols are used in religious art.
Y6	<u>Native Americans</u> The pupils will take inspiration from Native American cultures. They will explore a range of techniques including modelling, painting, sculpting and weaving to create their final piece.	<u>Old masters young writers</u> The pupils will learn how to appreciate and interpret a range of styles in art. They will take inspiration from a range of pieces and produce text inspired by the artwork.	<u>Pop art</u> The pupils will explore the pop art movement and take inspiration from key artists.
