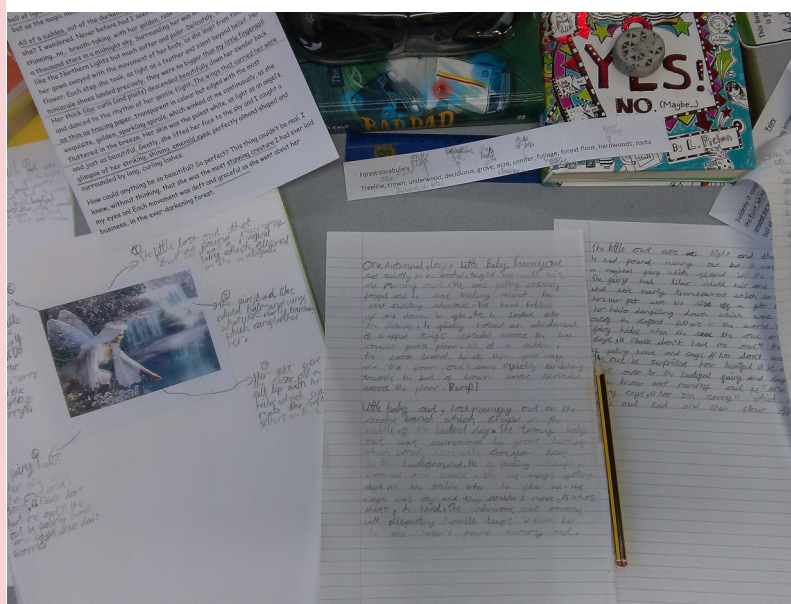

Well done to Noah for winning Fish-keeper of the week! Thank you for all of your help to clean the filter and for helping to keep our fish happy and healthy.

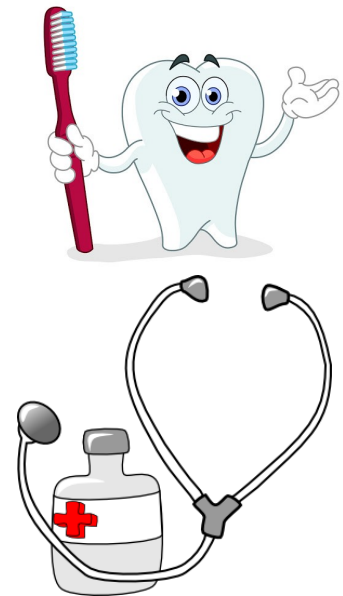


Half Term Activities
