THE BAD NEWS

Despite the above achievements, we are still not Ofsted ready. Our whole school percentage is still well below 95% and it has taken us 7 weeks to increase by 0.7%! We do not have enough school weeks left to only improve our percentage by 0.1% a week. Along with my newsletter, you will receive your colour coded registration certificate and if yours is red or amber then you can do more to help. Don't forget to book appointments around registration times and only keep them off if it is essential or they are contagious.

In addition, 26 families will have received a letter from me informing them that their child is on our 'Passport Scheme' and will need to come and see me every morning so I can stamp their passport. This will continue until their yearly percentage is close to 95%. I understand that some of these children may have had a percentage of 100% for the last half term, but overall their percentage is still not at 95%...YET!!!
