Nature of support 2012/13

Single year group classes were maintained to ensure high pupil to teacher ratios and quality first teaching.

Additional support from teaching assistants in the classroom to facilitate small group teaching and intervention programs and to focus on identified children in various year groups for 1 to 1 work.

Additional support from teaching assistants to support the social emotional needs of children, significant barriers to learning, early reading development and children in their first years of education who require additional support and nurturing.

Music Tuition was purchased for year 4 children.

Subsidy for residential visits, school trips and school excite days.

Purchase of additional resources to support vulnerable readers.

Additional TA time to deliver Every Child Counts maths intervention.

Staff development activities funded to ensure that all children receive quality first teaching.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The school will evaluate the impact on each pupil during autumn term 2013. Evaluation will focus on academic gains and how pupils' self-confidence has developed as a consequence of the intervention.
