Removal of Concessionary Activities within Wirral Council Leisure Services

We have been advised by Wirral Council that from April 1 2016, they will no longer be able to provide free swimming in the school holidays as part of budget savings.

They have asked us to let you know that:

Pupils receiving the pupil premium will still be able to swim free and that a process to administer this is still being developed and we will let you know when this is available.

They have asked us to remind you that Invigor8 leisure passes are available from as little as £15 a month, and include access to all of the council's fitness suites, swimming pool, exercise classes as well as discounts on pitch, court and equipment hire.
